As Lutheran Christians, we believe in the INCARNATION; that is that Jesus became flesh and dwelt among us. We believe that this Jesus is 100% human, born of the Virgin Mary as well as 100% divine, begotten of the Father. We talk about this at Christmas and even read John chapter one on Christmas morning; however, this incarnation doesn't end at Christmas! Jesus continues to live as the “Word made flesh” throughout His ministry as we watch Him reveal both human nature (hungry and weeping) as well as His divine nature (miracles and works). Even in His resurrection, we see both natures residing together, yet the incarnation doesn't end there! Rather, Jesus begins to dwell in the hearts of His followers at Pentecost when the Holy Spirit comes upon them! Jesus continues to put on human flesh each day to go out and share all that He has done to bring about the salvation of all who believe. You are the incarnation that Jesus continues to work through and minister to this world! Your human flesh is broken with sin and yet Jesus comes to you to make you whole in His forgiving grace in order to work wonders through you as you share the grace and truth of Jesus with all the world. Our families embody Jesus when we do these devotions center on His Word so that we are sent out to proclaim the truth of Jesus's love to everyone in the flesh!
