Nehemiah (Fellowship Hall) As we look at the book of Nehemiah, we cannot help but identify with some of the struggles humanity faces. Difficult time settling into the way of life amid so many struggles and temptations after the exile. Facing opposition from those who would attack the faith. Then there is all the work to be done in rebuilding and reestablishing life as God's people in relationship with one another. Join Pastor Henderson as we walk through this wonderful book!

God's Trustees – Managing all of Life and Life's Resources for God's Purposes! (Cafeteria B) Do you know what it means to be a trustee? God provides us with far more resources than "time, talent, and treasure", and our responsibility for using these resources goes beyond "being a good steward". This excellent, interactive class will help you better understand how God equips us and trusts us to carry out his purposes. Each lesson includes time to seek wisdom from God's Word, to reflect and discuss ideas as a group, and to personally consider how to apply what you've learned.
